4-H Department Rules:

1. All rules for the Youth Department apply. Also the following rules as well as all State rules apply to the 4-H Youth Department.
2. All 4-H Entries will be scored on the Danish system. The Danish system of judging is based upon established standards of quality for each product. In this system, each exhibit is judged according to how well it meets that standard rather than how it compares with other exhibits. The following guidelines shall be used by the Judges:

1st	Superior	92%-100%
2nd	Good	84%-91%
3rd	Average	70%-83%

3. Age of exhibitor and years in a 4-H project should be stated on the entry form.
4. All 4-H exhibits must be made under the supervision of a project leader. List project year on entry form.
5. All entries in the 4-H Home Economics and projects divisions must have been made, collected, grown or prepared and entered by exhibitors who were enrolled in those projects in 4-H Youth Programs within one year on the opening date of the fair, except as otherwise noted.
6. All entries must have been made, collected or prepared by the exhibitor in accordance with the requirements or recommendations of that project program. Entries that require packaging and labeling, such as food preservation and entomology, must be done in accordance with directions and recipes in project manuals and outlines. Check carefully the recommendations for kind and size of container, and method of labeling. Only standard containers, specifically designed for the purpose, will be accepted.

4-H PROJECT LEVEL

- I. **Primary - Kindergarten - 3rd grade**
- II. **Beginning - Off to a good start and 1 year or less in project.**
- III. **Intermediate - 2-3 years in project.**
- IV. **Advanced - 4 or more years in project.**

3. Booth must be designed, constructed and installed by club members. Leaders may supervise only.
4. Entry forms must be signed by the club president. Leaders may not sign entry form as agent for clubs.
5. All booth materials must be stored within the booth.
6. ALL MEMBERS MUST BE SUPERVISED CLOSELY BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT.

Please use icing that will hold up during fair time. Royal or Butter cream icing would be recommended. These are available at any cake supply store. **Any entry without ingredient list will be turned away.**

All dried food in 1/2 pint jars. Please put your name on the bottom of each jar.
