1. All exhibitors in this department must be 18 or older.
2. All exhibitors in this department must be amateurs unless otherwise stated. An amateur is defined as any individual not earning more than 50% of his or her income from their craft
3. Entries will be accepted in classes for any others only from entries for which separate classes are not offered.
4. **All articles must be claimed on Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> 12:00 noon to 6:00 PM**  
The exhibitor or his/her representative must present claim checks to reclaim exhibits. Management will not be responsible for unclaimed exhibits.
5. **Entries in this department do not entitle exhibitor to passes to the fair.**

6. Exhibitors must obey all rules for entries to be accepted.
7. All entries must be prepared by the exhibitor within two years prior to the opening date of the fair. **EXCEPTION:** Homemade Wine, Homemade Beer: No more than four (4) years prior to the opening date of the Fair.
8. The utmost care and protection will be given to all entries, however, Management shall not be responsible for accidents or losses that may occur to any of the exhibitors or exhibits at a show. The exhibitors shall hold the management harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such an accident or loss.
9. Sweepstakes will be awarded to the exhibitor scoring the highest number of points per category as per point system. A total of 25 points must be achieved by at least three (3) exhibitors for Sweepstakes to be awarded in each category. An exhibitor must have a minimum of 10 points to qualify.
  - First Award ..... 5 Points
  - Second Award ..... 3 Points
  - Third Award ..... 1 Point

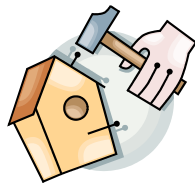

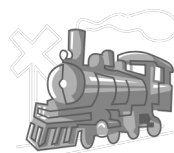

## PRESERVED FOODS

All entries in these divisions must be home prepared.

**STANDARD JAR:** Fruit and vegetables clear glass, wide or narrow mouth, Mason jar. Jellies clear glass, standard or sculptured, to be at least 7 to 12 ounces (sealed lids and rings bands). Jams clear glass, pints or half-pints, fruit jars only. NO PARAFFIN SEALS, ALL CANNING MUST BE IN SEALED JARS WITH BANDS.

**NON-ACID FOODS:** All vegetables, meats, poultry, and fish must be canned under pressure. Low-acid fruits, such as figs, should be made more acidity by adding lemon juice. Tomatoes and fruits (not including their juices) must be processed in a boiling water bath. FOR ALL JUICES, SYRUPS, FRUITS, VEGETABLES, AND PICKLES AND RELISHES, PLEASE BRING 2 JARS. i.e. pint, or 1/2 pint for judging, regular jar for display.

OPEN JARS MAY BE PICKED UP ON OPENING DAY OF THE FAIR FROM 4 – 9PM OR ON May 2, 2011. 12:00 noon to 6:00PM in Warren Hall. EXHIBITS MUST BE ACCURATELY LABELED.

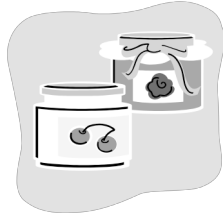
